Given under my hand at Camp Shelby, Mississippi this 1st day of April, one thousand nine hundred and forty-three.

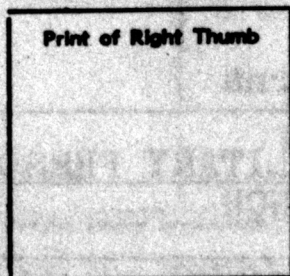
